Food Matching

As an aperitif...	Cumbrian Gin, Cumbrian Real Ale, Champagne or Prosecco.
Fish or shellfish...	Dry, crisp wines such as Colombard, Sauvignon Blanc, Verdejo or Chablis.
Chicken or pork...	Rich, full whites such as Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc. Verdejo works or light reds like Beaujolais.
Beef...	Big, hearty reds such as Malbec, Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere, Shiraz, Primitivo or Chateauneuf-du-Pape.
Lamb...	Medium-bodied reds such as Rioja, Tempranillo, Pinot Noir, Beaujolais or Merlot. Chateauneuf-du-Pape is also great.
Cheese...	Port, Primitivo or Chateauneuf-du-Pape. Sauvignon Blanc works too.
Desserts...	Champagne, Pink Prosecco or White Muscadelle. Kin Toffee Vodka or Kendal Mint Cake Liqueur are great local digestifs.

2. Watervale Chardonnay / Australia

A fresh, lively, fruit-driven Australian Chardonnay with a medium-bodied palate and a crisp finish.

3. Aves del Sur Sauvignon Blanc / Chile

8. Watervale Shiraz / Australia

Robust yet easy drinking this juicy fruit-filled Shiraz has a soft mouthfeel with a touch of spice. Great with all red meat dishes.

BETTER REDS

9. Aves del Sur Merlot / Chile

Aromas of ripe berry fruits on the nose, especially blackcurrant and damsons. Silky on the palate with soft, well-integrated tannins, the layered flavours of berry fruits and vanilla result in a satisfyingly long finish.

10. Verjus Rioja / Spain

A young and fruity Rioja which still manages to be effortlessly elegant. Soft and fruit-driven with delicious dark cherry and plum fruit on the nose all balanced with a hint of spice and a long warm finish.

14. Frog's Return Colombar / France

Pale yellow with green reflections. Floral aroma (white flowers) with a note of pineapple. Semi-dry wine round and pleasant on the palate easy drinking very fresh and expressive.

As good as only a true French Viognier can be: full-bodied, fragrant and rich with a flash of apricot, orange blossom and peach on the nose and a good weighty finish. Perfect on its own or with spiced or Asian-style cuisine.

16. Santa Digna Gewürztraminer / Chile

Golden yellow in colour, this Gewürztraminer from the Central Valley has a classic honey-and-Rosé bouquet. A fine, full-bodied wine with tropical fruit and perfumed characters, all balanced by a bite of refreshing acidity. Fair Trade.

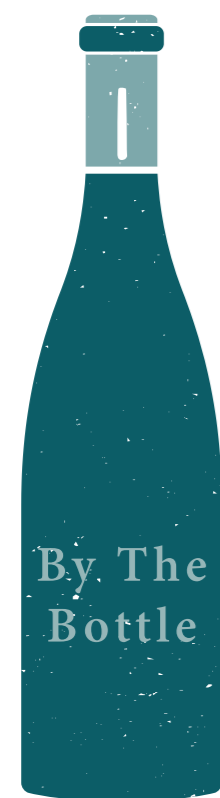
Freshness is key here delivering far from 'petit' flavour and steely minerality. Louis Moreau has been making excellent stylish food friendly and polished Chablis since 1814.

RED WINES

20. Frog's Return Syrah / France

Deep purple intense ripe black and red fruits spices and liquorice. The palate is round fresh and dense. Well structured with velvety ripe tannins. Long and aromatic finish.

21. Sea Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon / South Africa

Dark red colour. Ripe blackcurrant and plummy fruit flavours with toasty oak. Medium weight structure with a smooth finish and soft tannins.

22. Torres Santa Digna Reserve Carmenere / Chile

Cherry-red with aromas of mulberries, blackcurrants and eucalyptus, with a hint of mandarin orange. Elegant and rich on the palate with nuances of leather and spice; the spicy finish is velvet smooth from time spent ageing in French oak. Fair Trade.

23. Oltre Passo Primitivo / Italy

Ruby red with a nose of blackberry, cherries and ripe fruits, this full-bodied Italian red is beautifully smooth and balanced with a long oak finish. Perfect on its own or with any red meat dishes.

Aged for at least one year in American oak barrels followed by six months in bottle, this Tempranillo-Garnacha blend is everything you'd expect from a top-quality Rioja Crianza. Soft and smoky with warm vanilla and juicy red berry flavours, it is delicious enjoyed with roast lamb or tapas-style dishes.

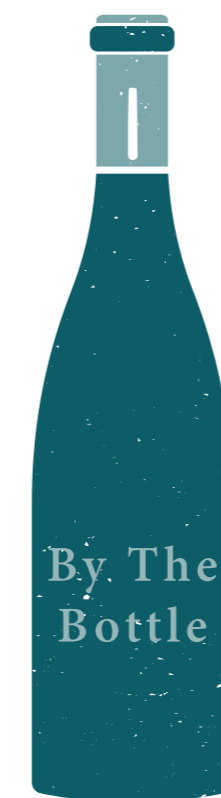

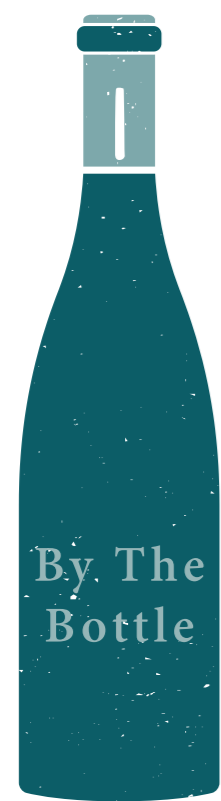
